

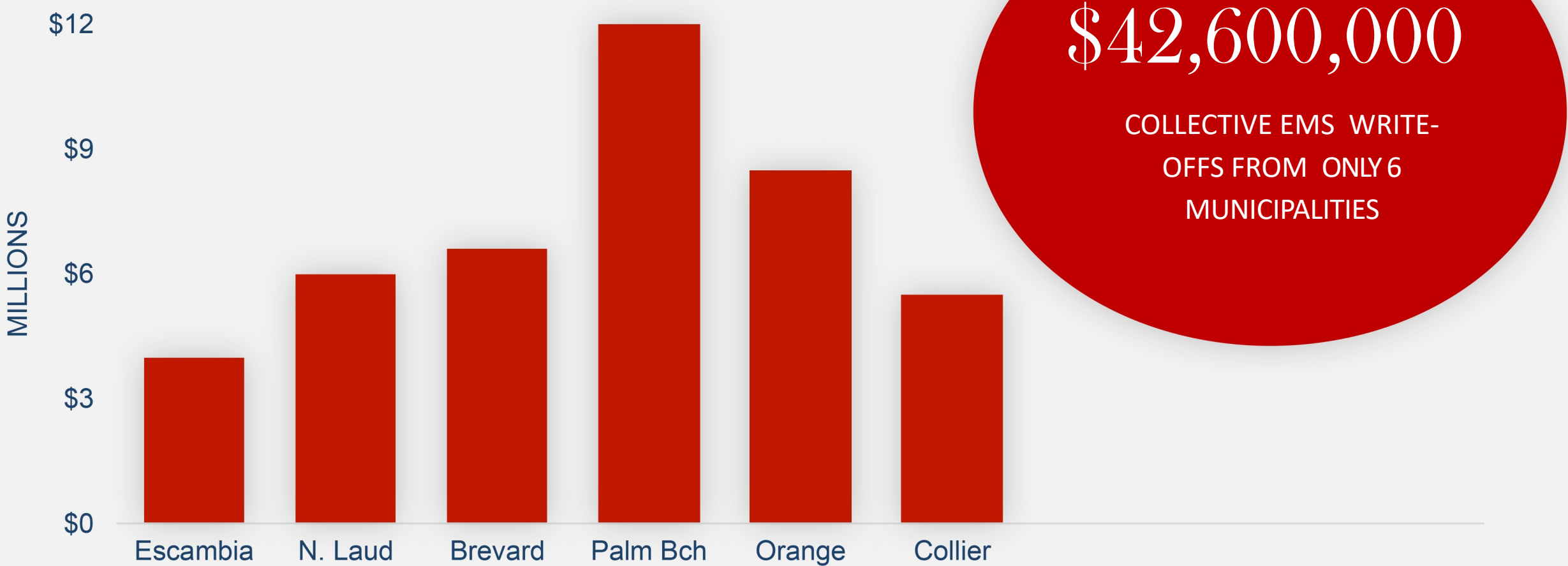

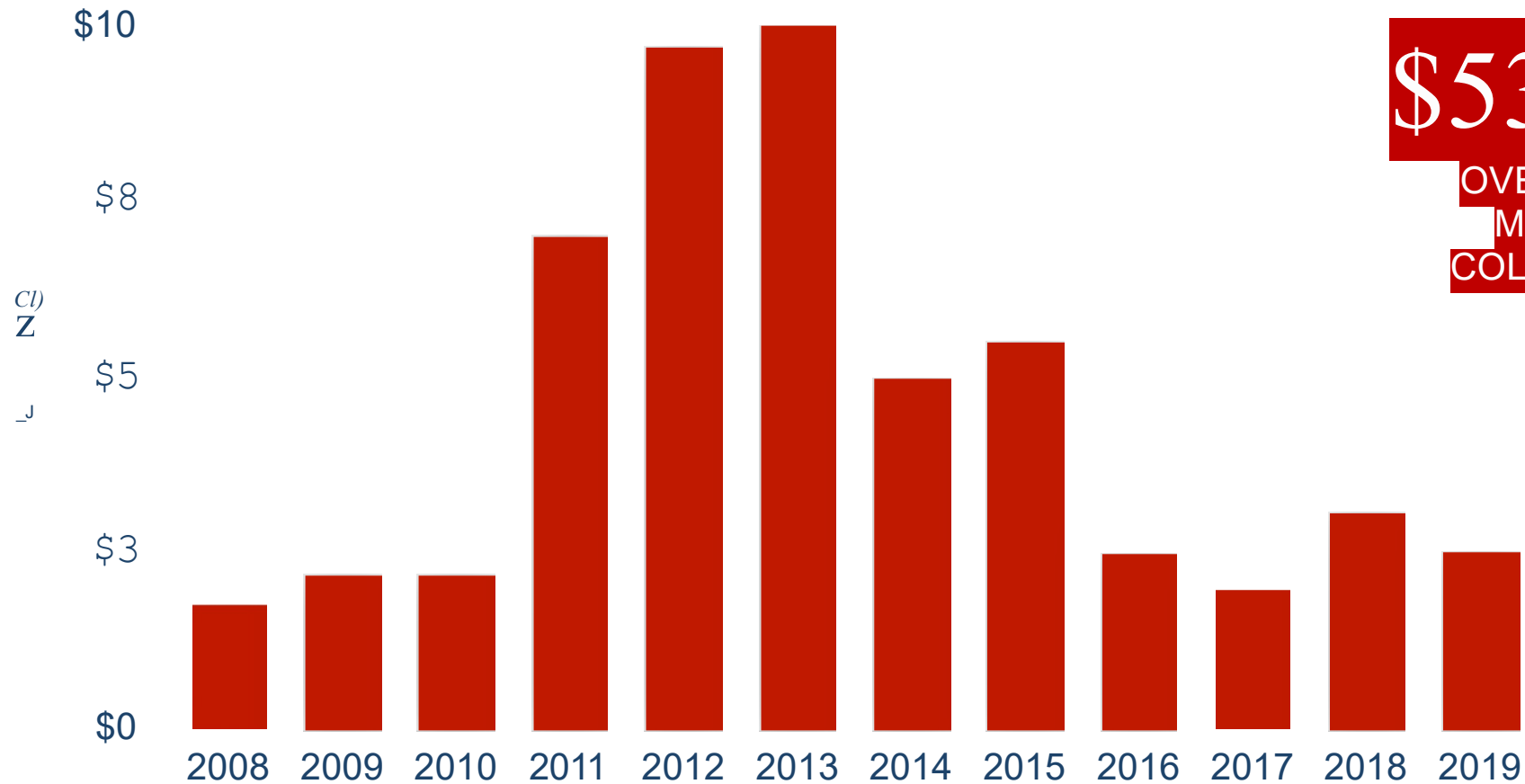

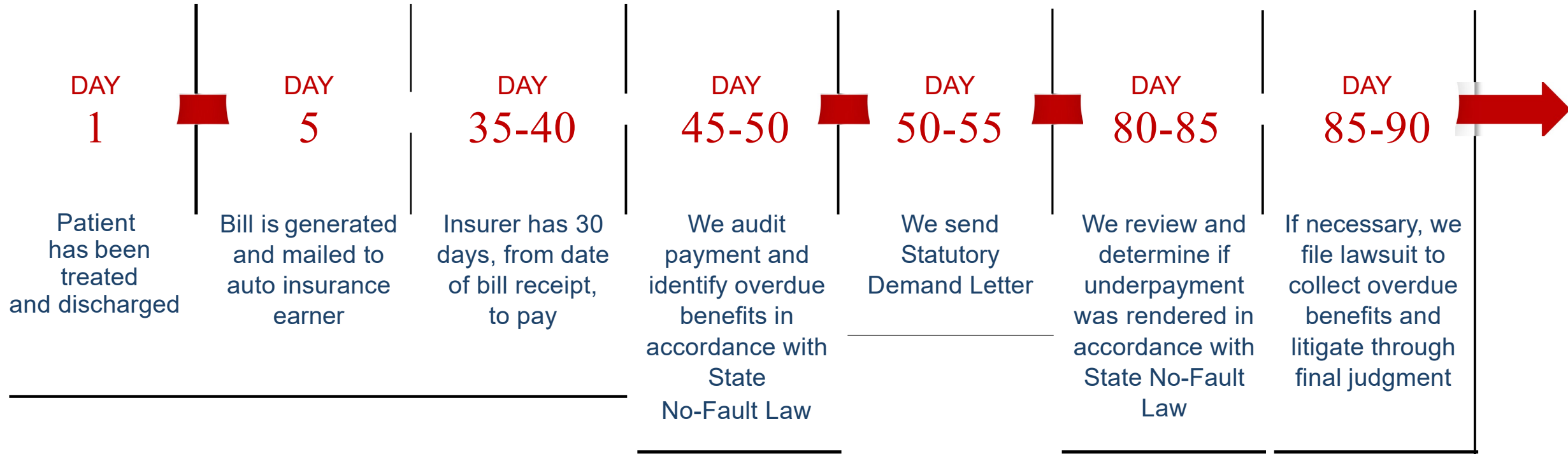

- 1) A copy of a current PIP payout log/sheet to determine whether benefits are available or exhausted;
- 2) The insured's declarations page, insurance policy, and endorsements;
- 3) The limits of liability for each policy disclosed;
- 4) A statement of any policy or coverage defense which you reasonably believe is available to you at the time you respond to this request;
- 5) All Explanation of Benefits and/or Explanation of Reviews; and
- 6) Reserve benefits to pay wrongfully reduced and/or denied claims

DEMAND IS HEREBY MADE FOR OUTSTANDING BALANCE AND REIMBURSEMENT OF POSTAGE COSTS IN THE AMOUNT OF _____

Pursuant to F.S. §627.736(10)(d), you can pay the above claim in full within thirty (30) days of receipt of this Notice of Intent To Initiate Litigation together with overdue interest and a penalty of 10% of the overdue amount paid by the insurer, subject to a maximum penalty of \$250.00.
